... sculpture of an elderly black man was created to memorialize the  
... shments and contributions of African-Americans in nineteenth century  
... The statue was the brainchild of Jackson L. Bryan, who was born in  
... Louisiana in 1868. Jack Bryan and his twin brother Joe played with African-  
... as children, worked with them as adults, and had a strong close association  
... an-Americans all their lives. Jack Bryan became a successful cotton planter,  
... and banker in Natchitoches, Louisiana. In 1926 he decided to commission  
... statue "dedicated to the faithful service of black people who had played an  
... role in the building of Louisiana."

... lected Hans Schuler, Sr. (1874-1951) to sculpt and cast a statue in bronze
